In the afternoon, visit Obernai's Christmas Market, featuring 40 chalets with local treats, wine, jams, and unique mulled wine. Discover artisanal crafts and festive decorations against the backdrop of Obernai's illuminated historic buildings.

Dinner is on your own tonight. Your hotel in Strasbourg's historic center is the perfect base to explore nearby restaurants. Your guide can recommend great dining spots.

Day 3

Enchanting Colmar and Eguisheim

Eguisheim's market has been awarded the "Villes et Villages de Noël" label for its authenticity and traditions. Explore traditional foods and Alsatian wine at the chalets. This evening is at your leisure.

Explore "emotional cuisine," a unique concept blending three artistic dimensions: a passion for cooking, poetry, and painting. Conclude this immersive experience with a delightful tasting session, savoring your creations transformed into a high-quality 3-course dinner and associated beverages (wines, crémant, saké, and soft drinks).
