Trip Overview



Engage with the local Maasai community through visits to traditional bomas and unique women-only discussions, gaining insights into their daily lives and entrepreneurial efforts. Throughout your adventure, friendships will flourish as you share morning wildlife hikes and exhilarating night drives, spotting elusive nocturnal creatures. The iconic Serengeti National Park offers breathtaking wildlife experiences, including the Great Migration and an optional hot-air balloon ride with a champagne breakfast. Your journey culminates in the Ngorongoro Highlands, where you'll explore the world-famous crater, home to the Big Five, and unwind at the luxurious Gibb's Farm, savoring gourmet meals after a thrilling safari. Experience the magic of Tanzania, from the dawn in the Serengeti to the majestic wildlife roaming the plains.

Mount Meru Game Lodge

This former private residence is located on the outskirts of Arusha and has been a refuge for injured or orphaned animals for over 15 years. Homey, comfortable cottages are placed throughout the garden, while in the main building, an elegant lounge and dining area offer a quiet place to relax and share safari stories. At one end of the picturesque garden, there is a semi-enclosed park-like setting where marabou stork, zebra, gazelle, warthog and even elephant recover from injuries obtained in the wild.

Day 2

From Arusha to the Eastern Serengeti

After breakfast, embark on a short scenic flight from Arusha to the Eastern Serengeti Ecosystem. Your guide will meet you at the airstrip, ready to share insights about the region's wildlife and conservation efforts. As you journey to your camp, enjoy wildlife spotting along the way—giraffes, ostriches, and perhaps even leopards. Immerse yourself in Maasai culture by visiting a local boma, where you'll learn about their vibrant community life. Conclude your day with a warm welcome dinner, celebrating the start of your Tanzanian adventure.

Your Nyumba offers exquisite, environmentally responsible comforts and personalized care. En-suite bathrooms have water-saving safari showers and self-contained, pump-flush toilets. This is Tanzania at its boundless magical best.

Day 3

Discovering the Eastern Serengeti

Awaken to the sounds of the Serengeti and enjoy a light breakfast before heading out for a magical morning hike across the plains. The afternoon is reserved for wildlife viewing, where you might spot rare species like the bat-eared fox. In the evening, gather around the campfire to listen to captivating Maasai folktales shared by elder Nekaaki Kioki, deepening your cultural experience in this beautiful landscape.

Day 4

Cultural Immersion and Night Adventures

The morning hours are perfect for wildlife viewing, offering chances to see silver-backed jackals and elusive big cats. Today, you'll engage with the Enjipai Women's Group, a collective of Maasai women focused on entrepreneurship. Enjoy a unique women-only discussion, sharing your experiences while learning about their lives in a polygamous society. As night falls, venture out for an exhilarating night drive, seeking nocturnal creatures like spring hares and aardvarks — an adventure few travelers experience in Tanzania!

Day 5

Journey to Serengeti National Park

Set off for your next Nyumba camp with plenty of wildlife viewing along the way. You might witness a dramatic chase between predator and prey or spot a leopard lounging in a tree. Enjoy a boxed lunch en route to maximize your time in the wild. In the afternoon, explore the Serengeti's vast landscapes, where big cats and other wildlife are often seen relaxing amidst the savannah. Settle into your new Nyumba and unwind with evening activities or simply enjoy the tranquil surroundings by the campfire.
